

Unison Products Closes Series A Financing

Substantial investment in "Invisible Speaker" company led by Polaris Ventures

August 5, 2005, West Newton, MA – Unison Products, Inc., the developer of invisible speaker systems, announced today that it has closed on a significant investment, led by Polaris Venture Partners of Waltham, MA. The funding will be used to complete the development and commercialization of Unison Products' patented *Edge Motion*™ speaker systems.

"We strongly believe that Unison has an important new technology that will change the way speakers will be integrated into consumer electronics and other display-based devices," said John Gannon, general partner, Polaris Ventures. "As manufacturers keep trying to squeeze more multimedia capability into smaller and smaller packages, it is hard to imagine a more elegant solution than what Unison has created. The team has done a great job of developing a speaker system that is destined to become a key component in a wide range of applications."

"We knew the technology we had been developing was something special," said Kevin M. Johnson, Chairman and CEO of Unison Products. "In our discussions with manufacturers, there has been clear validation of our value proposition – speaker systems that sound better and take up less space. This additional vote of confidence from Polaris and our other investors is a great vote of confidence in our ability to impact the consumer electronics industry. Now we have the resources to move forward with the development and deployment of commercial designs."

Unison Products develops embedded audio solutions for leading electronics manufacturers that "disappear" into the display enclosure. *Edge Motion*™ speaker systems offer several significant benefits over conventional speakers. This patented technology uses small actuators to drive the side of a thin, flat or slightly curved membrane. Using optically transparent materials, full range mono or stereo speakers literally disappear into the display enclosure, reducing the need for separate speaker enclosures and unifying the sources of both the audio and visual content.

Gannon will represent Polaris Ventures as a member of Unison Products' board of directors. The Venture Capital Fund of New England also participated in this investment round along with a group of private investors that funded the initial development of Unison's core audio technology. No other details about the transaction have been released.
